






EFFORTS BY PROGRAM




EFFORTS BY PROGRAM SUB-CATEGORIES






DEMOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN


Of note: Many groups reported also serving highly vulnerable populations to human trafficking, including LGBTQ+, immigrants and refugees, and individuals with disabilities.
